



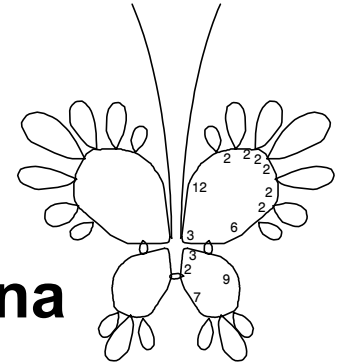
Palmetto Tatters Guild announces its
