

TEAPOT DOODLE

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This easy “doodle” is one ring with 25 double stitches, a long double picot for the teapot’s handle, a medium picot for the spout, and a regular picot for the knob on the lid.



- R A ring.
- A regular (but smallish) picot.
- A medium-sized picot (about 3/16-inch long when closed).
- A long picot (about ½-inch long when closed).
- +() A regular join to the place described in parentheses.
- Cl R Close the completed ring.

Wind Size 10 thread onto a shuttle.

Start between the teapot’s lid and its handle.

R: 2—3+(the end of the long picot)12—6-2 Cl R.

Tat a teapot doodle, leave an inch or more of bare thread, and then tat another. Keep going until you have a string of teapots as long as you like!
